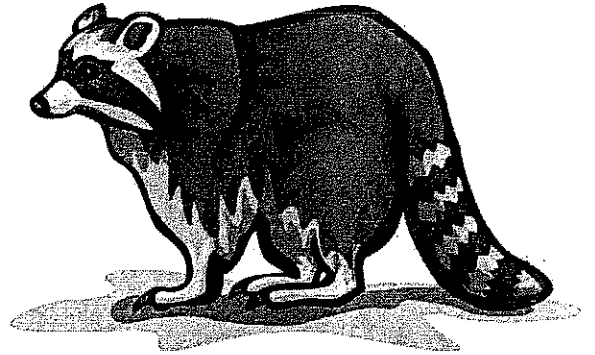
I walk by night, in darkness.

I move with stealth and grace.

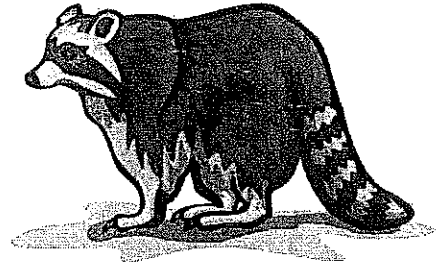
I steal from people's garden plots,

Adam yanked the blankets off the bed. "It wasn't a dream. I was awake, and the closet door started opening by itself!"

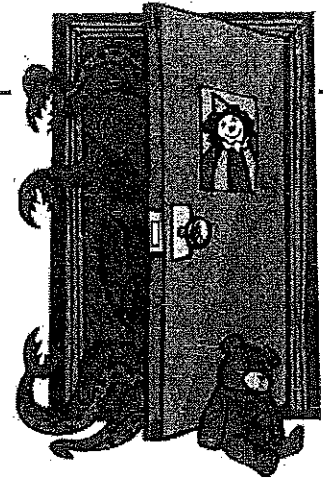
