### Renaissance Program

Renaissance is a program designed to recognize, reward, and motivate our students who excel in three specific areas of achievement; Academics, Attendance, and Behavior. The members of the Renaissance Program will be extended privileges associated with the various levels of excellence. Our goal is to make each student believe they can succeed in school and therefore in life. The purpose is to recognize and reward those students who achieve specific standards of excellence with tangible incentives and rewards. Renaissance is a partnership between the students, staff, parents, administration, business community, and community at large. Renaissance is a commitment to make Winslow Township School No. 5 a center of academic excellence.

#### **Requirements**

**Attendance** – No more than two days of unverified absences/lateness from school during each marking period.

**Behavior** – No administrative disciplinary issues during each marking period.

#### **Academic Standard -**

- Gold Card – All A's in core subjects
- Green Card – All A's and B's in core subjects

- White Card – All A’s, B’s and C’s in core subjects

**\*\* Students must maintain a “C” or above in all special area classes in order to participate in the program\*\***

### **Incentives & Privileges**

**All Renaissance Members:** Any student that has earned a Renaissance card in that current marking period

- **“A is for Applebee’s” coupon** – Students will receive a coupon for a free shake from Applebee’s
- **Renaissance Sponsored Item** – All students will receive a Renaissance sponsored item to commemorate their participation in the program.
- **Winslow School Five Lanyard-** All students who receive a Renaissance card will receive a Winslow School Five lanyard and plastic protector for their Renaissance card to be displayed daily. (Those who do not have their Renaissance card displayed may not receive the card’s privileges.)

**GOLD CARDS:** All A’s in core subjects

- Hall Pass Privileges – Students with a Gold Card can use it as a hall pass
- Preferential Lunch Line Status – Students with a Gold Card will be called up to the lunch line first
- Buddy Day- Students will sit at the lunch table of their choice on Fridays
- 3 Late Homework Exemptions (this does not include projects or papers.)
- Free admission to school events
- Admission to School No. 5’s Renaissance Happenings

**GREEN CARDS:** All A’s and B’s in core subjects

- Preferential Lunch Line Status – Students with a Green Card will be called up to the lunch line second
- Buddy Day- Students will sit at the lunch table of their choice on Fridays
- 2 Late Homework Exemptions (this does not include projects or papers.)
- Half off admission to school events
- Admission to School No. 5's Renaissance Happenings

**WHITE CARDS:** All A's, B's, and C's in core subjects

- Preferential Lunch Line Status – Students with a White Card will be called up to the lunch line third
- 1 Late Homework Exemptions (this does not include projects or papers.)
- Admission to School No. 5's Renaissance Happenings
